Reporting to the Manager, Baffin Region Rehabilitation Services, the Audiologist is the sole practitioner of Audiology services in the Baffin Region. The incumbent will provide, develop, implement and evaluate audiology services and programs for all residents of the Baffin Region in accordance with the Code of Ethics of the Canadian Association of Speech-Language Pathologists and Audiologists. This Audiologist will have an enormous impact on the hearing status of Baffin residents by providing specialized audiological assessment, diagnosis and intervention for individuals with hearing loss.

The successful candidate will have a Master's degree in Audiology, certification and membership in the Canadian Association of Speech and Language Pathologists and Audiologists. You must have the ability to case manage and provide comprehensive care to patients of all ages in a manner that is respectful and considerate of their cultural diversity. Excellent communication/computer skills and the ability to work co-operatively with other members of the health care team are essential.

Knowledge of Inuit language, communities, culture, land and Inuit Qaujimagatuqangit is an asset.

Equivalencies that consist of a combination of education, knowledge, skills and abilities to formal education and experience requirements will be considered.

This position is included in the Nunavut Employees Union and has a starting salary of **\$87,224** per annum, plus a Northern Allowance of **\$15, 016** per annum.
